❑ Education Service Commission: 30th September, 2010



Coseke has been awarded the contract for provision of consultancy services to complete the Development of an Electronic Database for Teaching Personnel in the Education Service Procurement Reference No. ESC/SRVCS/2009/10/00189. This project will entail digitizing of over 1,000,000 records into a state of the art electronic teacher's database with a temper proof environment housing the national teachers' database for all appointed teachers. This system will be used to verify teachers' appointment instruments hence weed forged entries into the system.

❑ Uganda Bureau of Statistics: 27th September, 2010



The Bureau of statistics has awarded Coseke (Uganda) Limited to Supply, Configure and Commission an **Automatic Data Capture and Form Processing System** with (**AnyDoc Software**) PROC REF N^o. UBOS-UNFPA/SUPP/09-10/0006/01. The purpose of this project is introduce the automatic data capturing technology to the bureau team for acquaintance purposes in preparations for the 2012 National Census.

UGANDA:

❑ Ministry of Lands; **Currently** we are implementing data conversion in the National Lands



Information System project for all land records; over 500,000 titles across the Country with their supportive documents which constitute over 25,000,000 sheets are being converted into digital; also Cadastral Maps and Microfilm are being converted into digital and uploaded into the Ministry of Lands digital archive repository. This is a World Bank Project being managed by Private Sector Foundation Uganda. Note: Data conversion is just a component of the National Lands Information System.

❑ Ministry of Public Service; (9th September 2009 – July 2010) After the ministry struggling to



access crucial information from employ files for purposes of decision making especially during appraisals, payment of salaries, processing of pension etc. the Ministry of Public Service procured the services of Coseke (U) Ltd to Supply, Configure and Commission an **Electronic Document Management Systems (EDMS)** with

(Case G360 Software) and digitize 5,000,000 documents of government employees from 11 project pilot sites into the EDMS. Even before the commissioning of the system life is becoming better at the ministry. Information accessibility and sharing is no longer a nightmare. The second phase of this project is going to cover all government personnel in all its institutions.

❑ **Education Service Commission:**



(November 2009 – March 2010) In Phase one Coseke deployed a state of the art electronic teacher's database with a temper proof environment housing the national teachers' database for all appointed teachers. Over 3,000,000 documents were digitized in this exercise and the result was a system that is used to verify teachers' appointment instruments hence weed forged entries into the system.

- ❑ **The Public Procurement & Disposal for Public Assets Authority;** (1st December 2009 – August 2010) Coseke Supplied, Configured and Commissioned an **Electronic Document Management Systems (Case G360 Software)**. The EDMS will handle all the documentation in regards to national procurement and also help in expediting of procurement exercises. Note the entire business workflow at PPDA is going to be automated into this EDMS.



❑ **Privatization Unit**

Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development; (17th October, 2008 – June 2009) An electronic / digital archive was designed by Coseke with an objective for the easement of access to all former Public Enterprise records. Currently with the manipulation of an Electronic Document Management System information at PU can easily be accessed and shared hence help in quick decision making. A total of 24,000,000 records were also de-shelved and physically archived into boxes.



- ❑ **Budget Monitoring and Accountability Unit (BMAU) Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development;** (18th July 2008 – December 2009) Coseke helped



implement a poverty digital records archive for the ministry of finance. This archive will be used by all researchers for academic purposes and also public administrators for purposeful decision making. Over 4,000 Poverty Related documents from all resource centers in Uganda and outside the country were scanned and index into a National Digital Poverty Reference Archive.

- **STATE HOUSE (REPUBLIC OF UGANDA);** (July 2008 – August 2008) We Coseke



participated in the implementation of an Electronic Document Management System which will be used by the office of the president. Information security was a priority and distribution and access a core factor of this project. The project is a phased one and at the end of it all the burden of carrying files around for meetings will be history in the office of the president due its availability in the EDMS on the Local Area Network, Wide Area Network and the Web.
